## A Note from Swamp Meadow's Executive Director

Welcome to the last show of our 2014-2015 season.

We billed this past season as representing a return to “tradition.” We opened our season with our Summer Children’s Theatre presentation of *Annie, Jr* (in August). We followed this traditional show with traditional Americana, as we presented Thornton Wilder’s *Our Town* (in October). For the holidays, we recreated a traditional show that showcased one family’s slightly offbeat traditions in *A Christmas Story*.

Now, we round out our our season with *Little Shop of Horrors*, which, we acknowledge, probably did not represent “tradition” for most of us, except in its offbeat Americana.

In addition to these shows, we continued our own tradition of hosting a dinner theater: *The Complete Works of William Shakespeare (Abridged)*, in March. (Though, in keeping with the concept of “Abridged,” this was a dessert theater, instead of a full dinner theater.)

While last season’s we focused upon “tradition,” this season, we focus on “classics.”

We will open our new season in August, with our Summer Children’s Theatre, as they present Mark Twain’s classic, *Tom Sawyer*. For the holidays, we will present, once again, Charles Dickens’ classic, *A Christmas Carol*. And, for the spring, we present a modern classic, *M\*A\*S\*H*.

We hope that you will join us for all of these shows and events this year, and make us a part of your own tradition.
